- 6- The entrants shall be responsible for the costs of production, maintenance, safety and good condition of his/her work or content at the event, and African Fashion Week Ottawa shall not be held liable for losses or damages of the work submitted for the event.
- 7- Photographers, videographers and media will be present at the show. Images or moving images will contain African Fashion Week logo and entrant's logo if paid.
